



Australia & New Zealand C-Tick

Before a product covered by the EMC regulatory arrangements can be sold in Australia it must be labelled.

The label is comprised of a C-Tick mark and a unique supplier identification. The C-Tick mark is intended for use on products that comply with EMC standards.

The label indicates that the product complies with the applicable EMC standard and establishes a traceable link between a product and the supplier responsible for placing it on the Australian or New Zealand market. The use of the C-Tick mark cannot be transferred to another party without the prior approval of ACMA or RSM.

The C-Tick mark is a certification trademark registered to ACMA in Australia under the Trade Marks Act 1995 and to RSM in New Zealand under section 47 of the NZ Trade Marks Act. The C-Tick mark is only to be used in accordance with conditions laid down by ACMA and RSM.
